1. Giving in Acts

During the period following Pentecost, money was laid at the feet of the apostles. This was distributed as was needed (Acts 4:32-37). Great grace and great power was upon these early believers as they shared things in common.

The first sin and Divine judgment in the early church was over money withheld in deceptive giving. Ananias and Sapphira were judged, not because they did not give, or even give all, but because of lying to the Holy Spirit and acting as if they had given all (Acts 5:1-11).

In Acts 6:1-6 seven men are chosen to care for widows in the early church. These had been neglected in the daily ministrations. Perhaps they had been taken care of previously temple services. Over the years, some widows were even supported by the church if they had certain qualifications (1 Timothy 5:1-16).

Under a time of famine, the disciples took a collection of financial relief for the saints in Jerusalem and Judea (Acts 11:27-20 with Romans 15:15-29; Galatians 2:10; Acts 20:33-35).

In the early church, there was a spirit of grace and giving on the saints as they ministered to one another and to those in need. The principle of this was simply a continuation of the laws of freewill offerings to minister to poor and needy as established already under the law covenant.

2. The Teaching of Paul

The greatest apostle outside of the Twelve was Paul, the apostle to the Gentiles. It is in the Pauline Epistles that we find Paul's teaching on the matter of giving. Paul confirmed the principle of giving of both tithes and offerings.

(a) Paul Confirmed the Principle

of Tithing

The writings of Paul, ex-Pharisee of the law, and Christian apostle to the Gentiles, confirmed the principle of giving tithes and offerings.

It was probably but a short time when support by tithes and offerings for the temple priesthood and services ceased. The period of transition would see support going now to the ministers of the gospel, ministers of the New Covenant, as believers came out from the Old into the New.

That support for the ministers of the gospel should continue is confirmed by Paul in a number of illustrations. This is seen especially in 1 Corinthians 9:1-14. Paul shows that, even under the Old Covenant, the ones who served at the altar were supported by the things of the altar. He uses the law to establish the truth that ministers of the gospel that they minister.

Paul fully supported the fact that the Levites were supported by the tithes of the Israelites who brought the sacrifices to them. Although the word "tithe" is not specifically mentioned here, the whole of the "tithing principle" is in Paul's mind.

gift is for us to give to our neighbor. He did not intend for us to be alone.

Rule #8: They eat breakfast every morning. There have been countless studies that prove that breakfast is the most important meal of the day. It gives you energy to start your day and your metabolism.

Rule#9: They are on some type of vitamin regime. Unfortunately, with all of the processing that our food goes through, a lot of the natural nutrients and vitamins are lost. We need to take extra vitamins to supplement our food intake. Speak with a nutritionist or doctor prior to beginning a regime to check for conflict and dosage.

Rule #10: They stop eating when they are full. Unless it is Thanksgiving or Christmas dinner you should not be eating until you feel like you are going to bust. Stop eating when you are full, even if you don't clean your plate. Put it up for later.

1. 1 Cor 9:7a The Warfare—Government Taxes—Ministers are soldiers in spiritual warfare for the kingdom of God 2 Cor 10:4; 2 Tim 2:3-4

2. 1 Cor 9:7b The Vineyard—The fruit eaten—Ministers are caring for God's vineyard-church and may partake of the fruit produced. Deut. 20:6; 2 Tim 2:6; Isa 5:1-5

3. 1 Cor 9:7c The Flock of God—Drink the milk—Clothe with wool—Ministers partake of the milk and wool from the flock as God's shepherds. John 21:5; 1 Pet 5:1-2

8. 1 Tim 6:17-18 Matt 10:10 The Labourer—Hire and reward—Ministers Labour for the Lord, His people, in the word and doctrine. Worthy of double honour. 1 Tim 5:17-18; Lev 19:13; Luke 10:7; Deut 24:14-15

9. 1 Cor 9:14 The Gospel Preacher Teacher—Live of Gospel—Ministers who preach the gospel should live of the gospel, for so has the Lord ordained.

Paul takes each of these Old Testament illustrations. Each illustrates the principle of support for New Testament writers of the gospel, even as the Levitical priests were supported under the Old Covenant.
