ment agencies which are currently affected by the downturn in the economy.

Though the odds may seem to be stacked against the efforts to build facilities to help child prostitutes, Starr Kennedy is not deterred. "We have no idea where the money will be coming from," she said and added, "but the amazing thing is that God always provides when you're at the center of His will."

The Kennedys stated that the current lack of care facilities in Las Vegas is "shocking" and that they are heartbroken by the current practice of sending child prostitutes to detention centers just so they can be safe. "They are re-victimized, absolutely," said Starr who strongly believes that every minor working in prostitution is a victim and not a criminal. "Kids don't choose to be prostitutes," she explained. "They aren't willing." Starr also pointed out that the costs of a care facility are about half of that as a detention center, something the government really needs to take into account.

The Way Out has been working for more than two years to plan the operations of their proposed facility and to navigate all of the legalities involved. Because of their desire for the program to be Christ-based, they will be precluded from some government funding sources, said Earl. "We won't compromise and have to offer Jesus Christ as a healer," asserted Starr. Earl also mentioned that the acceptance of federal funds would put the facility under some federal governance that child victims would have to testify against their pimps and perpetrators. That's a situation The Way Out would like to avoid if at all possible. "The same laws that are meant to protect kids are the same laws that can be troublesome," Starr pointed out.

As for willing hearts, Earl said, "So far, God has put an awesome team together" for the facility. "We do want to have more churches involved," he added. "We'd love to do a mentoring program and have this be a mission-capable facility," he explained.

As they work, The Way Out is banking on prayer and awareness. Judge Voy's efforts also seem to include the mission to attract more attention to the problem of trafficking and the need for facilities. With hundreds of thousands of victims in the United States and only about 50 beds, according to a government report in 2010, in purpose-built facilities, there is a huge need for ways to help child prostitutes.

"The main issue is recognition that this is a serious problem in the United States," said Earl. "The government denied that this is an issue here for too long," he said. "It is just now coming to the surface," he explained.

tional job doesn't always allow for adequate time to serve. Using the resources of SendOutCards and leaders such as Hazzlerigg, people often work with the company for 3-5 years and generate enough passive, residual income to support their lives for years after that.

Hazzlerigg explained that SendOutCards serves many levels of customers and employees. Some people just want to send out cards on a personal basis, she said. Others use SendOutCards to support fundraising and marketing efforts for existing organizations, she explained. There is also a large group of people who want to use SendOutCards to support themselves financially. For that, she utilizes her extensive experience in coaching as well as specialized marketing tools to help people build their own businesses, but not before she helps them to work on themselves.

"I'd say that 95% of what we do is personal development," said Hazzlerigg. She explained that people need the ability to manage their time well, confidence to engage with others, and a clear sense of their goals. "Anyone can do this," she said, "but not without the skills."

Through all of it, Hazzlerigg said she is motivated by the ways in which SendOutCards really is

changing lives. "The stories are amazing," she said. "Whether it's mending relationships or gaining financial freedom," Hazzlerigg said she is a constant witness to love and caring. She has seen people become financially self-sufficient and take power over their lives and relationships. And although SendOutCards is based on the multi-level marketing model, Hazzlerigg said she has never felt that sales are the mission. "I don't consider it sales; I consider it sharing," she explained.

Though she is four years into working with SendOutCards, Hazzlerigg said she still feels as though her career is "in the building phase." She feels energized at this stage, she explained, and wants to build on that momentum. As for the future, she said, "I don't see me ever stopping, but I do see me spending less time on the business and more time in service." She has a heart for the human trafficking issue and has also been an active fund and awareness raiser for the Crohn's & Colitis Foundation of America since being diagnosed with Crohn's disease.

For those considering pursuing self-employment or something like SendOutCards, Hazzlerigg advised that people in full time jobs should maintain their employment as their own businesses are developing. "If you have a full time job

and need income, don't quit it," she said. "Put in extra hours and find the time to build your business on the side so you don't have the pressure of needing the new business to generate immediate income," she added.

Hazzlerigg also advised that people really look at their beliefs and seek out career coaching. "Get the right tools and the right mentor," she said.
